

## PROTECTIVE REGISTRATION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Protective Registration is a FREE service to the public to protect one's identity against impersonation. Protective Registration is provided by the Southern African Fraud Prevention Service (SAFPS).

Your details will be added to the SAFPS databases and be made available to the Member Organisations of the SAFPS for use in assisting to protect you against future identity fraud. The SAFPS will only use and process your information in accordance with our respective privacy policy.

Please be aware that this Protective Registration filing will alert the SAFPS Member to take precautionary measures to ensure that you are protected. They also need to ensure that they are indeed, dealing with the genuine owner of the Identity Document. It is possible that your application may be delayed whilst your identity is being confirmed, and you may be requested to provide additional information to the SAFPS Member in this regard. Please be aware that this is being done to protect both yourself and our member organisation.

The SAFPS and their Members **ACCEPT NO LIABILITY OR RESPONSIBILITY** of any nature. By applying for Protective Registration, you accept that this exclusion is reasonable. You must take all other necessary precautions to protect your identity. The SAFPS is a non-profit organization and is not connected to any Government department or the South African Police Service. It is funded by its members' annual fees.

By applying for and requesting Protective Registration, you hereby:

- i. declare that the information and facts provided by you in this application are within your personal knowledge and are true and correct; and
- ii. agree to the information provided by you being made available to Members of the SAFPS and to other bona fide agencies for the purpose of fraud prevention; and
- iii. indemnify the SAFPS, Secure Citizen and their Members, Agents and Servants against any liability, loss, claim or proceedings whatsoever, whether arising in common law or statute, however arising out of the course of or caused by the carrying out of any service by the SAFPS, whether due to any act or omission of the SAFPS or their Members, Agents or Servants or otherwise; and
- iv. understand that making a materially false declaration is a criminal offence, punishable by law; and
- v. confirm that you have no objection to making this statement and certify that you take full accountability for the content thereof.
